Allan Cunningham, born in London in 1791, was appointed the botany collector for Sir Joseph Banks in the early 19th century. As part of his explorations, in 1828 he discovered a route to the fertile soils of the Darling Downs from Moreton Bay. That route is now called Cunningham's Gap.

Today we'll visit the property he used as his camp at the base of The Main Range for a picnic lunch followed by a hike with tea and damper.

After checking into our accommodation, we'll head into town for an old fashioned country town pub dinner (own expense).

Lunch (own expense) will be at the nearby Scenic Rim Brewery & Cafe which is a small family-owned brewery located in the picturesque town of Mount Alford.

This afternoon we get to spend time shopping for fresh local produce of the Scenic Rim with the charismatic and passionate locavore Caz Osborne.
