The Margaret Olley Art Centre (MOAC) celebrates the career, life and legacy of Margaret Olley, Australia's most celebrated painter of still life and interiors. MOAC combines exhibitions, interactives and the permanent re-creation of areas of Olley's famous home studio.

There is a delightful cafe on site with stunning views over the countryside. Grab a coffee and cake or lunch before departure.

The tour finishes after the visit. Return transport to Toowoomba for those who require it.
